

ETB Contracted Training Tender Stage 2

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The Office of Government Procurement has issued an RFT for the provision of contracted training services to Education and Training Boards Ireland (ETBs).

There are 15 Education and Training Boards participating in this Framework Agreement. There are seventeen (17) regional Lots. Each ETB will be the Contracting Authority for their individual ETB; Framework Contracts will be issued by respective ETBs to successful Tenderers.

Stage 1 was closed in April 2017.

The following are the categories that your application will be judged under Stage 2 of the tender.

Course Recruitment	Student Management with individual student logins, progressions and tracking of communication. (Talk to us about integrations with your CRM or eLearning.)
Course Development	Removes duplication, cloning of Learning Outcomes, Milestones and checklists, plans and specifications.
Course Admin & Management	TAQ's system auto-calculations taking away Friday nightmares. We can build automated F3's to F48 to your region's requests.
Tutor Procurement & Delivery	Tutor procurement features including experience, qualification, travel/location and daily rate management.

Receipted Expenses	Using fully mobile responsive tutor application to evidence both course outcomes and additional expenses.

In addition, under QQI White Paper Sector Specific Guidelines for ETB's It requires that contractors

- Have fit-for-purpose governance, management and decision-making structures.
- Have arrangements for providing required information to the ETB.
- Have sufficient resources, as well as corporate, structural and internal quality assurance systems in place, to sustainably provide education and training programmes.
- Evaluate the effectiveness of a provider's quality assurance procedures for the purposes of establishing, ascertaining, maintaining and improving the quality of education, training, research and related services offered by the provider
